Goals & Context

GOALS/VISION

There are multiple goals for this organization:

Big, Hairy, Audacious Goal:

To give a basket twice a year to all of our neighbors in the world who live with a mental illness

Big, Hairy Goal:

To give a basket twice a year to all of our neighbors in Minnesota who live with a mental illness

Big Goal (20/20 vision):

To give a basket twice a year to all of our neighbors in the metro area who live with a mental illness by 2020

Original Goal:

To give a basket once a year to all of our neighbors in the metro area who live with a mental illness

2011 Goal:

To give a basket to 1,300 of our neighbors in the metro who live with a mental illness (half-way to Original Goal)

CONTEXT

When making decisions on behalf of Open Baskets, ask yourself and others these questions:

Mission:

- Does this fill the heart, mind, and/or soul of our neighbors who live with a mental illness?
- Does this support filling the heart, mind, and/or soul of our neighbors who live with a mental illness?

Vision:

- Does this bring us closer to fulfilling the 20/20 Vision?
- Is this in the best interest of Open Baskets?
(As opposed to my best interest or someone else's best interest)

Ethics:

- What would your mom say if she saw you doing this (the 'Mom Test')?
- What would MHR say if they saw you doing this (the 'MHR Test')?
